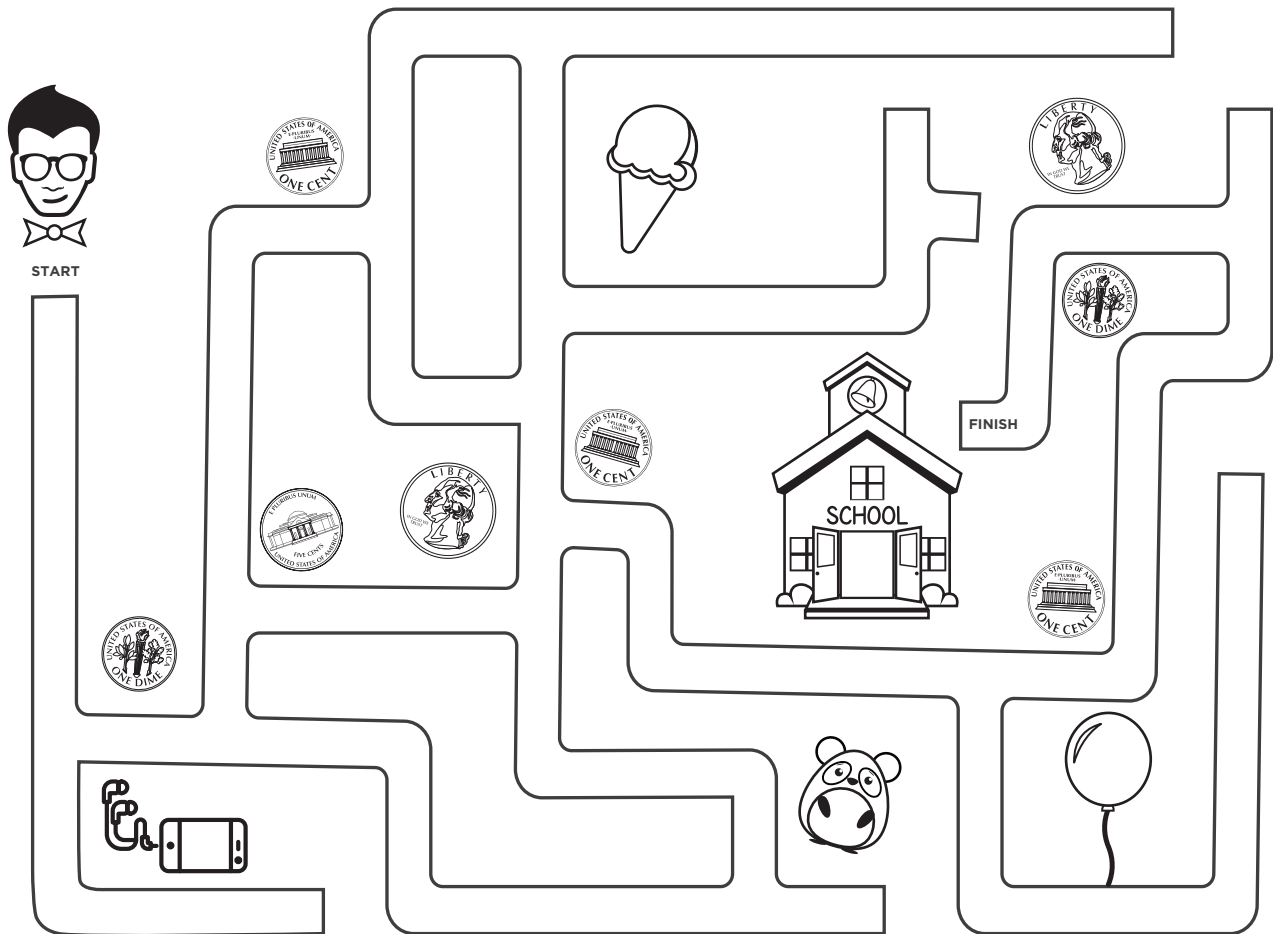
A NEW SCHOOL YEAR IS JUST AROUND THE CORNER. HELP WALTER SAVE AND SHARE TO GET READY.

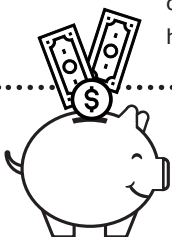


How much money did Walter save? _____
